Butterfly Feeder

Materials:

Pie Tin

Twine

Hole Punch

Scissors

Citrus Fruit

Beads (optional)

- 1. Punch four holes in the pie tin lip. In the pattern of North, South, East and West.
- 2. Measure and cut four pieces of twine (about 18 or more inches.
- 3. Insert a string through each hole in pie tin, then tie a knot to secure them to the tin.
- 4. Create a pattern with the beads to a desired length on each string. Keep in mind that butterflies love bright colors.
- 5. When finished, bring ends of the strings together and tie at the top.
- 6. Cut up fresh "butterfly fruit" and hang in a desired location. Try oranges, soft bananas, berries, pineapples, melons, papayas, pears and plums cut into chunks or slices.
- 7. Hand it up outside and watch for butterflies!
